

To get started, I first broke down the project into six sections:

- Research & Ideas: tasks for completing research and creating new ideas
- Pre-Production: storyboarding, scripts, location, and time selections
- Production: test film and recording
- Post-Production: editing, YouTube creation, audience testing, and final touches
- Posted: reserved for the four different videos
- Complete: small tasks will be placed here to clear up space in the main sections

These separate sections allow me to easily see what needs to be completed and what is already done. Each task is then broken up into smaller tasks. I created descriptions and checklists for most of the items I need to complete. This helps me to stay organized when there are many things to do. I also have added the Posted and Completed section for additional organization to clear away tasks that no longer need my attention.


RESEARCH & IDEAS

I also have plans to annotate my bibliography to stay even more organized. Annotating the sources allows me to get a brief description of the contents of the website, video, or book.


PRE-PRODUCTION



The first thing that I need to do during pre-production is to create storyboards for each video. This will allow me to create a visual representation of what my videos should look like.



POST-PRODUCTION




