Sketching

A mind map is a visualization that organizes information. Based on hierarchy, the map shows relationships and connections across a theme or question.






11 Ideas Generated

- 1.Reading app like Goodreads, but when you click on a button, you get to see everyone's progress that is currently reading the book at the same time you are.
- 2. The tab allows you to see the thought and feelings of others that are on the same page as you.
- 3.A ranking system while you're reading. Allows you to rank 5-1 stars while reading to see if you started off hating/ loving the book, but then your feelings changed.
- 4. Seeing data for everyone that is reading the same book as you. How many sittings? Ranking throughout? Thoughts Throughout? Would recommend? Ah-ha moments?
- 5. Put spoiler warning on thoughts and feelings brief.
- 6. Community posts for that specific book.
- 7. Discussion questions for people to answer.
- 8. Helpful comments if someone is confused while reading.
- 9. Reporting bad reviews. Giving a reason for reporting unhelpful/ bed reviews.
- 10. Not allowing anyone to post a review that hasn't read the book.
- 11. Not allowing people to comment if they haven't read the book.


